## ELECTRICAL CODE AMENDMENT REGULATION

This notice is intended for all Albertans who may have cause to use the new Electrical Code Amendment Regulation.

### Codes in Force under the New Regulation

The following Electrical Codes are adopted under the Electrical Code Amendment Regulation (Alberta Regulation 176/2013) and come into force on **October 1, 2013**, under the *Safety Codes Act*:

- **CSA- C22.1-12 – Canadian Electrical Code Part 1** – This code provides the minimum safety standards for the installation and maintenance of electrical equipment.
- **Code for Electrical Installations at Oil and Gas Facilities – 4th Edition, 2012** – This code applies to electrical installations used in the search, transmission or production of oil, natural gas and related hydrocarbons, and it provides area classification guidelines.
- **Alberta Electrical Utility Code – 4th Edition, 2013** – This code provides the minimum safety standard for the installation and maintenance of electrical utility systems in Alberta.
